

# DISTRICT 15 STaC CONDITIONS OF CONTEST

SANCTION NUMBER ST1004048

March 29 – April 4, 2010

- 1). All games will be stratified. Strata are:
  - A – 1500+
  - B – 500 - 1500
  - C – 0 – 500
- 2). Clubs may hold a ONE or TWO SESSION SWISS TEAM EVENT and may, at the local director's discretion, use the above strata or adjust the strata to achieve three teams in the lowest strata. SWISS TEAMS ARE NOT DISTRICT WIDE EVENTS.
- 3). GAMES MUST HAVE THREE (3) TABLES TO QUALIFY FOR DISTRICT OVERALL RANKING.
- 4). PLAYERS MAY PLAY IN ONLY ONE GAME THAT WILL BE SCORED IN THE SAME SESSION.
- 5). District wide hand records will not be used.
- 6). We encourage invitational games to open their sessions for this event. Restricted games will be scored as side games. We also encourage clubs to add sessions at any time during the STaC that do not conflict with established games in the area.
- 7). STaC GAME SETUP.
  - a. Set up as usual until you get to Event Rating.
  - b. Choose Option (9) the Sectional Tournaments at Clubs for game rating
  - c. Associate with a club by putting in your club number.
  - d. Enter the number of strata for your game (3) and enter the strata limits for the tournament.
  - e. Choose proper event restrictions. For the open games, the correct number will be 0.
  - f. Enter the number of sessions. This will be one unless you are playing a two-session swiss.
  - g. Designate this event as a Multi-Site event. (Except for teams)
  - h. Enter the tournament Data.

Use the sanction number above.

Enter the Event Code from the list below.

The Event Codes you are to use are as follows:

The first two digits are the numbers of the session in which your club is sanctioned. Clubs holding additional games, use the event code for that session. The last two are for clubs entered in the stratified open pairs. If your game is a limited or invitational game then, for the last two digits, enter IP for invitational events, LP for events with an upper masterpoint limit, T1 for a one session swiss, and T2 for a two session swiss. If you are running any other types of games, enter XX for the last two digits. In cases of doubt, feel free to call Richard Mueller at (773) 592-0708.

8). Game results must be e-mailed to the Director in Charge, Richard Mueller, e-mail chirick11@yahoo.com within 24 hours of game end. Put the following information in the subject line of your e-mail: D15 STaC, ST1004048, and the file name. For example: D15 STaC ST1004048 100329.xxx. This will greatly assist the DIC to put your game in the proper session and speed the process of posting and accuracy of the results. Failure to report will result in your game being ranked separately as a side game and reduced masterpoint awards for your players. After your game is completed, make a backup copy of the game file and send that backup copy to the DIC. If you use ACBLSCOR, you may use the BACK command to backup your game file. Save it to your root directory(c:\). The file will have a filename of 1003xx.acm, 1003xx.aca or 1003xx.ace for March games and 1004xx.aca, 1004xx.ace for April games. xx will be the day of your game. Attach it to the email and send to Richard. If you have yet to enter the computer age, you may call Richard with your results. Make sure you have a copy of the short press in front of you so that you can give him all the necessary information. This includes the ACBL number for all participants in your game and their percentage score. He will also need names of all non-members participating. Results and schedule will be posted on the WEB at the following address:

9). Some type of profit will be returned to the Unit as designated by the District 15 Board. A payment of 7.00 per table is due within 24 hours of the conclusion of the last session in which your club participates.
